Grundfos is implementing this online web solution because of growing demands within chemical legislation on a world-wide scale. It is a smarter way to secure chemical compliance in our products and furthermore gives a faster response time towards our customers.

As a preferred supplier to Grundfos we want to strengthen the collaboration further and therefore it is important that you sign up to the online web solution within a week.

The system is a 1:1 system, so the data you give in stays between you and Grundfos.

Already a user of IMDS?

CDX and IMDS are interlinked, which means that by creating a user in CDX you can transfer your IMDS data to CDX and send to Grundfos.

Simply answer yes/no to compliance status

With the online web solution, we give you in the first place the possibility to answer yes/no to compliance status, for you to start slowly and getting to know the system.

Phase out of SVHCs


